**National Lutheran School's Week:** Teachers and students enjoyed the activities as we celebrated our Lutheran school this week. Thank you to everyone who participated!

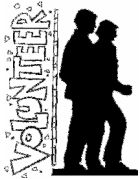

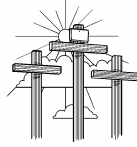
## SPRING EXCITEMENT!

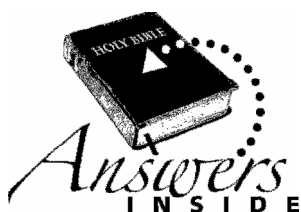
