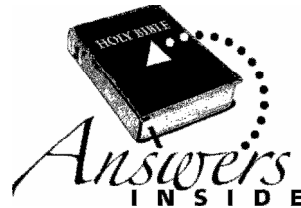
Used Book Sale / Fundraiser: St. James School
