- † Mrs. Glessing that she will continue to heal and get stronger each day.

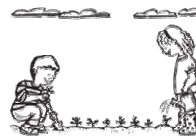

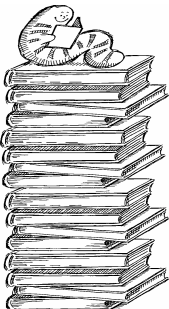
