Chapel Offerings: Chapel offerings given from now until the end of the year will go towards building a Lutheran School in Anapra, Mexico.

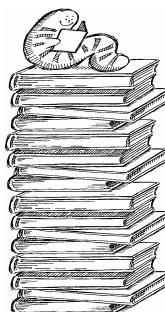
At the first chapel of every month, the school collects donations for the Food Shelf.

Herbs: cilantro, lemon balm, chives, mint

Vegetables: cabbage, broccoli, cauliflower, tomatoes

Flowers: marigolds, alyssum, coventry, pansies, and possibly more.

Perennials: hostas, tansy, ribbon grass, mums

There will also be some gladiola bulbs, and cala lily bulbs.

A new item that has been added will be flowers arranged in pots for the deck or steps.
