Campbell Soup Labels: The Campbell's Company has revised the manner in which it will redeem labels for schools. The front panel will no longer be accepted. Instead clip and send in the UPC. You are not expected to do the clipping. Just send the entire label so that the UPC code may be trimmed and sent in. Prego lids and V8 Splash lids are also part of the collection program.

General Mills Box Tops: For each box top collected, our school receives 10 cents. Please clip the labels off the box flaps and send them in.



Kemps or Land 'O Lakes Milk Caps: For each milk cap collected, the school receives 5 cents.



Cell Phone and Printer Cartridges Recycling: Old cell phones and empty laser and inkjet printer cartridges are collected. Only name brand laser and inkjet cartridges are accepted. CHANGE: Remanufactured or damaged cartridges are NOT accepted.



The items listed above may be dropped off in the School Office.
